

## Year 7 Catch Up 2019-2020

### English

Number of pupils who did not reach EXS in reading 2019: 22, 2 have now left the school. Of this group, there were: 11 girls and 12 boys (2 have since left (now 10)). One student was EAL and 4 students were SEND K. Of the 22, 16 were Pupil Premium and 3 were Lower attainers at KS1 (2 boys and 1 girl).

### Maths

62% of our students achieved a score of 100+. With the special circumstances uplift that proportion grew to 66%. Of the 32 students who did not achieve EXS, 5 were disapplied and three were upgraded to 100+ leaving 24 students not at EXS

10 of the remaining students were not expected to achieve 100 according to KS1 data. 6 were male, 4 female. 30 % were SEN and 70 % were PP. The average scaled score of these students was 94. 14 students who were expected to achieve 100+ did not. Of those students 9 were girls and 5 were boys. One was SEN and 9 were PP students. The average scaled score of these students was 96.
